A Word from the Director

"Horror is a funny old genre for a musical, you may think. I know I certainly did, before I got to work on this show. There's the well known *Rocky Horror Picture Show*, *Little Shop of Horrors* and, I suppose, *Sweeny Todd* could even be classed as a "horror" musical. But these shows are hugely outnumbered by the romantic, the pastiche the Disney.

I suppose that's why I was attracted to this project in the first place; the chance to do something a little bit different. That, and the opportunity to work with a young cast. Having young people on stage is always interesting. It's refreshing to see what they bring to a production, how they look at things from a different perspective.

So, when I sat down to write the script, the horror trope of "the haunted house" seemed a good starting point. I've always liked the kind of scary movie that's set in a remote, isolated location. I particularly like Daphne du Maurier's *Rebecca*, the sense of remoteness in her novel and the film version becomes very unnerving. Hence, *Thirteen* is set in Cornwall, England.

Rather than have Satan as the main evil presence, I chose to go down a more mythological line. I spent a lot of time researching the links between Greek mythology and Cornish folklore. The Greek Gods could be capricious, jealous, vindictive, irrational But they were "human" in a sense, and I wanted to bring that over in the script of *Thirteen*.

A big thank you to all the cast and crew involved. It's been challenging at times, but I'm sure the end product is something we can be proud of.

A Word from the Musical Director



"Being musical director of a show where there is no band and the singers perform to backing tracks isn't necessarily easier, it is just different. The tracks have to be adjusted or created afresh to suit the play and the singers have to be helped to work with an inflexible backing.

However, I did manage to find some time to build the set as well, so I must have won some time from somewhere.

This has been a fun show to work on and Neil has introduced me to lots of great pop music that I didn't know before."

A Word from the Choreographer

"Most choreographers were dancers at some point, and some dancers are choreographers. I have loved dancing for a while, and am just recently branching out into choreography, dabbling in the area in a couple of previous Pirate's shows.



One of the biggest challenges with choreography for a musical is organizing the movement on stage without getting the singers out of breath, since dancing alone and dancing while singing are two quite different things. When considering also that only a few cast members have a long history of dancing, it's the choreographer's job to make sure that they can do the moves and enjoy the process.

I am happy that Neil has given me this opportunity and I hope that the rest of the cast will look back on these moments fondly."

Synopsis

Act I

A single mother, Carine, and her three children move from London to the Cornish coast into an old house in the country along with their housekeeper, Liliya. They're greeted by the lovely folk of the town including Marrak the groundkeeper, Mrs. Pascoe their neighbor, and Mrs. Penhaligan, the President of the local Penwith Women's Institute. As they get settled into their new home, odd things begin to happen, starting with the grandfather clock that doesn't stop at twelve chimes on the stroke of midnight. Unbeknownst to the family, some of these friendly townspeople have other plans up their sleeves that start to come together during a night to (not) remember at the bar.

Act II

An unexpected romance begins to blossom between Carine and the local bartender, Cesare, although the children don't seem so enthusiastic about it, worried that their mom is moving on too fast, and with a much younger man. However, things soon go south as Persephone meets the lord of the underworld, the children get called to the principle's office, and Cesare vanishes from the town. All seems lost in this new place as the annual Easter celebration approaches, possibly their last chance to help this town.

Featuring songs from Stevie Wonder, Blondie, The White Stripes, and many more, *Thirteen* has a little something for everyone to enjoy.


